Multiple Group winner The Taj Mahal has a pedigree with impeccable credentials, hailing from one of the most prolific and best families in the stud book.

The Taj Mahal is a full brother to Champion 2YO Colt and Champion Miler **Gleneagles** who is described by Coolmore as having 'the ultimate sire's pedigree', with his first crop yearlings selling up to 600,000 Euros in 2018 and already the sire of two winners from just two runners. In addition to Gleneagles, The Taj Mahal is a full brother to three additional Group winners including Champion 2YO Filly Happily.

Hailing from the prolific family of Mariah's Storm, his second dam, The Taj Mahal is out of the Group 2 winning Storm Cat mare You'resothrilling, a full sister to **world class sire Giant's Causeway**, who sired 31 individual Group 1 winners and was named Champion Sire in North America on three separate occasions in addition to becoming a highly successful broodmare sire.

By the great **Galileo**, who has produced sixty Group 1 winners to-date and is a sire of sires with his highly successful sire sons, Frankel, Teofilo, and New Approach, The Taj Mahal is bred on the same Galileo/Storm Cat cross as European Champion 2yo and dual Guineas winner Churchill.

27% of Galileo's Group 1 winners are out of mares from the prolific **DANEHILL** line,

suggesting that The Taj Mahal will also nick with these mares. Other ALMAHMOUD family members such as **MACHIAVELLIAN** (sire of **STREET CRY**) and mares carrying sons of **HALO** also appeal.

The Taj Mahal's damsire Storm Cat has an affinity with **NIJINSKY II**, so mares carrying **ROYAL ACADEMY** appeal. As **FASTNET ROCK** is by Danehill out of a Royal Academy mare, his daughters tick all the boxes for The Taj Mahal.

Mares by **ROBERTO** or his sons create a desirable sex balanced duplication of Roberto with The Taj Mahal.

Line breeding to Sadler's Wells' tail female line has worked well for Galileo. Damsires carrying this family include ENCOSTA DE LAGO (and other FAIRY KING sons), NUREYEV, PERUGINO and THATCHING. ZABEEL mares carry two lines to this family.

Four Group 1 winners by Galileo have **MR. PROSPECTOR** up close in their dams' pedigrees and he also works well with Storm Cat.

In summary, The Taj Mahal looks to have a bright future at stud, due to the astronomical quality of his pedigree in conjunction with its predicted compatibility with many lines commonly found worldwide.

Stamina and Speed!

In a short career in Australia, The Taj Mahal showed top class speed and stamina characteristics with two wins in the 2400m G2 WFA Zipping Classic.

He achieved his peak in 2017, with a dominant 3.5L win over 2016 Melbourne Cup winner Almandin, who would go on the following Autumn to win the G1 WFA Tancred Stakes over 2400m at Rosehill and Big Duke (4.8 length away in 3rd), a three-time Group 1 placegetter who was coming off a 4th placing in the 2017 Melbourne Cup.

In the 12 months spanning his two Zipping Classic wins, **The Taj Mahal's WFA Performance Ratings of 103 and 102 ranked in the top 10 performances we** saw in Australia at 2400m. He was the only horse to record two performances in the top 10.

The Taj Mahal's greatest asset was his high cruising speed and the ability to run fast overall time!

His time rating winning the 2017 Zipping Classic was +11 lengths faster than the average Metropolitan winner's time rating at 2400m or further over the past 4 seasons.

He also showed similar speed over 2040m when he won the 2018 G3 JRA Cup at Moonee Valley, recording a time rating that was +10 lengths faster than the average Metropolitan winner at 2000m over the past 4 seasons.
